Zontians work together and experience the satisfaction of making a personal contribution to improving women's lives in their local communities, as well as through support of international efforts.

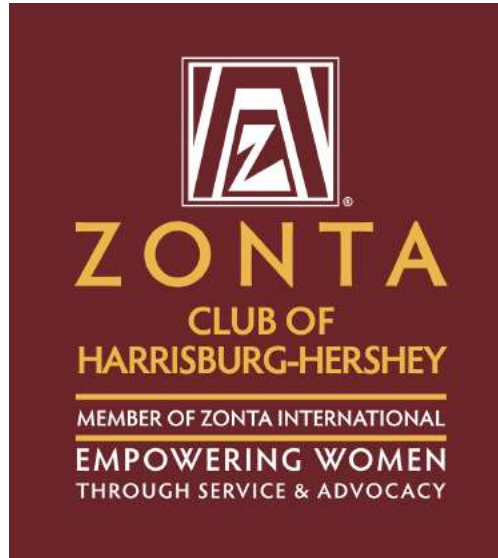

Established in 1919, Zonta International is a leading global organization of professionals empowering women worldwide through service and advocacy. Headquartered in Chicago, there are over 30,000 members in more than 60 countries. Zonta International envisions a world in which women's rights are recognized as human rights and every woman is able to achieve her full potential. In such a world, women have access to all resources and are represented in decision making positions on an equal basis with men. In such a world, no woman lives in fear of violence. The Zonta Club of Harrisburg-Hershey was chartered in 1980. It is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization.

What does "Zonta" mean?

The name is derived from the Sioux Indian language and means "honest and trustworthy".
